


Discover 10 resources, scroll down to IHS Markit, you can click on the heart so it will always appear at the top




This is the new home screen, type in here to search for the item you want



As you can see in the green boxes on the right it retains my recent searches




This shows the result for BS 9999, click on the title which is showing in red. The next slide shows you must agree to terms and conditions to view the document, this will appear every time you want to look at an item.




When you view British Standards, in fine print, every page will include the Fire Service College and your name, please do not share any standards that you download.

This new platform requires a bit more information when searching, for example, if you are looking for fire service manuals, you need to put HMFSI FSM or HOFPU FSM, they are using publisher details as an initial term. Another example is technical standards, for more in depth guidance on theatre's and larger places of entertainment, The shot below I applied ABTT from the list of publishers, sadly they are listed by the number of documents they produce and only use initials!



There are literally thousands of items free to download, including those available from Government sites, HSE so search away. This is a search for the fire risk assessment documents, 12 appear in the list, but not the Offices and shops guide no 1, you will need to search offices and shops separately to find the newer version.



Its not so straight forward as the old platform and I'm still learning my way round, so I hope this guide will give you some idea of how to navigate your way round!
